

Online Registration 2018 FAQ's

What is online registration?

Complete and total registration for all football players and cheerleaders, coaches, volunteers and officials in an organized, electronic process designed to improve data accuracy and reduce the administrative hours required of our volunteers.

What is a Booster Club?

There are 10 Booster Clubs. Examples are: Klein Eagles, Tomball Patriots, Spring Lions, Oak Ridge Saints, etc.

Who has to register online?

Everyone. Flag football, tackle football, all drill team. There will be no more paper registration forms, waivers or contracts.

How do I register online?

Visit aayfdt.org. You will see "LOGIN" on the far left (below the Bengals and Broncos logos). That link will take you to a member login/create form. You (each parent/guardian, coach, volunteer, and official) will create your own member account. Once that step is complete you will see a screen and "Register Now" on the top left and the process begins.

Can I just print the forms and bring them to the in-person registration events?

No paper will be accepted. If you attend a registration event and bring printed/completed forms you will still be kindly directed to complete the electronic registration online.

Do I have to show up in person if I register online?

Legacy: Only to provide equipment and volunteer deposit checks or to make cash payments.

Open Registration: Yes. All copies of birth certificates, utility bills and report cards must be submitted in person. You may still pay online to expedite the process (this is highly recommended).

Does everyone have to register online?

Yes. No exceptions.

Can I register and pay online?

Yes. You can even request payment plans, make partial payments (varies by Booster Club).

Are there fees associated with paying online?

Yes, there is a 3.65% terminal fee assessed with credit cards. As of February 1, 2018 Checks will not be accepted as a form of payment for registration fees. Booster Clubs reserve the right to accept checks for fundraising buyout, volunteer deposit and equipment deposit on a case-by-case basis.

I don't have a credit card. How do I pay my fees?

Credit cards, debit cards and gift cards are accepted as forms of payment online.

I can't afford to pay all fees now. What do I do?

Payment plans are setup for extenuating circumstances. Please speak to a member of your Booster Club board to discuss a timeline.

I have multiple children in different activities within AAYFDT. How do I register them?

After creating your member profile, you will register each child individually. Make sure to select the right activity and age group. It is all done in the same online portal.

What if I don't own or have access to a computer, smartphone, tablet. What do I do?

AAYFDT is sensitive to these circumstances and is working diligently to have electronic devices available for just this occasion. We are aware that local libraries offer computer access with library membership. We will have one device available at our Registration Event to accommodate these instances.

When I visit the registration link it asks me (the parent) to create a profile. Can I skip this step?

No. Every parent/guardian will be required to create a member profile.

Can I upload my documents to avoid coming in person?

No. Due to the sensitive nature the documents we require we are only accepting hard copies. Contact your booster club if you have any questions.

My child attends a private school or a home school. How do I register if I don't know our Booster Club zone?

Use the "Find my Booster Club" tool on the Online Registration page to select the elementary school closest to your residence. When registering select "Home School or Private School." This will allow you to complete registration.

My child played for a Booster Club they we're not zoned to due to roster limits. I want to play for the same team and am afraid that I will be forced to play for a different team this year. What do I do?

Your child will not be transferred unless you request it. Per our legacy rules your child will play on the same team (for the same Booster Club) as last year/season. Here are the steps to follow: 1) Register for the Booster Club you played for in 2017, 2) Select "Yes" on Return to 2017 Team drop down 3) Select "Other" in the School list and enter your child's actual school

My tackle football player is playing-up, but I cannot register because of the age restrictions. How am I supposed to register?

You will have to register your player in the appropriate age group which is determined by their birthdate. Your player will be manually rostered by the league Athletic Director. If you have any concerns, feel free to reach out to your Booster Club President or Athletic Director.

I have a Legacy player/cheerleader and I've completed registration online. None of my child's information has changed and I've paid registration and fundraiser buyout via credit card. Why do I have to attend a registration event?

Please contact your Booster Club President. Each Booster Club manages their requirements differently.
